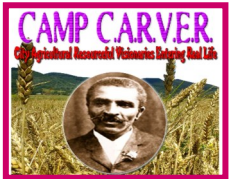

1. Create Awareness and increase participation among SDVBFR in Kansas and Missouri with knowledge and skills needed for them to start and operate profitable farm enterprises.
2. Enhance the ability of SDVBFR to rent, own and retain farmlands
3. Create awareness and increase participation in USDA programs and improve access to timely agricultural related information.
4. Improve Knowledge in identifying and adopting environmentally sound alternative enterprise through innovation and cost effective production practices
5. Increase marketing activities for SDVBFR, identify new markets, connecting them to existing markets, and assist them with effective marketing strategies.
